Popcorn Word Practice



Have your child:

- Find the word in a book or highlight it in the newspaper.
- Use magnetic letters on the refrigerator or cookie sheets to spell words.
- Cut out letters from magazines to spell words.
- Type the words on the computer.
- Use Alphabets cereal to spell out words.
- Show or print 1 letter at a time until the child guesses the word.
- Trace the letters of the word on your child's hand or on their back and have him/her guess the word.
- Make puzzles by cutting up the word and putting it back together.
- Have your child pick a word and write it on a piece of paper. Say the word.
- Use the word in a sentence.
- Have your child read the words as fast as they can. Use a timer to try to beat their time!

WRITE WORDS ON 3X5 CARDS. WRITE EACH WORD ON 2 CARDS SO YOU HAVE 2 OF EACH.

- Play "Concentration" and try to match 2 words.
- Play "Go Fish." Put all words in a pile. Each person draws 5 cards. If you have a match, lay the cards down. If you don't, ask the person if he has the word _____. If not, go fish and take a card from the pile. The winner is the one with most pairs.
