

MATH FACTS

We are using the Otter Creek program for math fact practice. These are one and two minute timings where each student is working on their own personal goal. Here are some ways to practice math facts at home with your child.

- Flash cards
- Fact triangles
- Deck of cards: choose two cards and add them together. The key is to work on speed and accuracy.
- Addition Top-It: using a deck of cards-just like war, each player flips over two cards, adds them together. Whoever had the higher sum gets to keep the cards.
- Dice: using two dice, have students roll them and add them together. Adjust this activity by using dice with numbers on them or dice with more than 6 sides.
- Dominos: Add up the two sides of the domino.
